That is to say. First after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged, the residue of my Estate real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows. To wit: (To my daughter Susan Harris and her son Dampie Harris the land I purchased of Rodman Wood situate in the aforesaid County and Township to be owned jointly during the life of my daughter Susan Harris and at her death the full title to said land to belong to Dampie Harris and his heirs, I also give to Susan Harris the Oldest Steer and to Dampie Harris the Young Steer and one cow, the first heifer calf that the said Cow has to be given to Susan Harris, and to Thomas Harris I give the Yearling Steer, The Cow now in possession of Martha Davenport. I will and bequeath to her. I give to William Jones one Bedstead now in possession of Lydia Ann Green. and to Margaret Ann Jones one Bake Spider I give and bequeath and divide all the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate to my Child Susan Harris. likewise I make and constitute and appoint my Grand son William Jones to be Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former will by me made.

to the satisfaction of the Court, it is ordered that the said Writing bearing date on the 12th day of August 1878. be recorded as and for the last will and testament of Abby Harris deceased.

On upon the motion of William Jones he is permitted to qualify as Executor of Abby Harris deceased, and together with Benjamin Daylor his Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, and it is ordered that letters of Administration be made out in due form of law for William Jones as Executor of Abby Harris decd.
