Pierce dec^d. Was thereupon ordered to be recorded to be recorded as the true last will and Testament of said Elizabeth B. Pierce dec^d. And on the motion of Felix Pierce the Executor therein named he is permitted to qualify as Executor upon the estate of said E. B. Pierce dec^d. Whereupon he appeared in Court and took the Oath prescribed by law and entered into and acknowledged his bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars (no security being required by the testatrix) with condition as the law directs and the said Felix Pierce is therefore legally qualified as Executor aforesaid.
