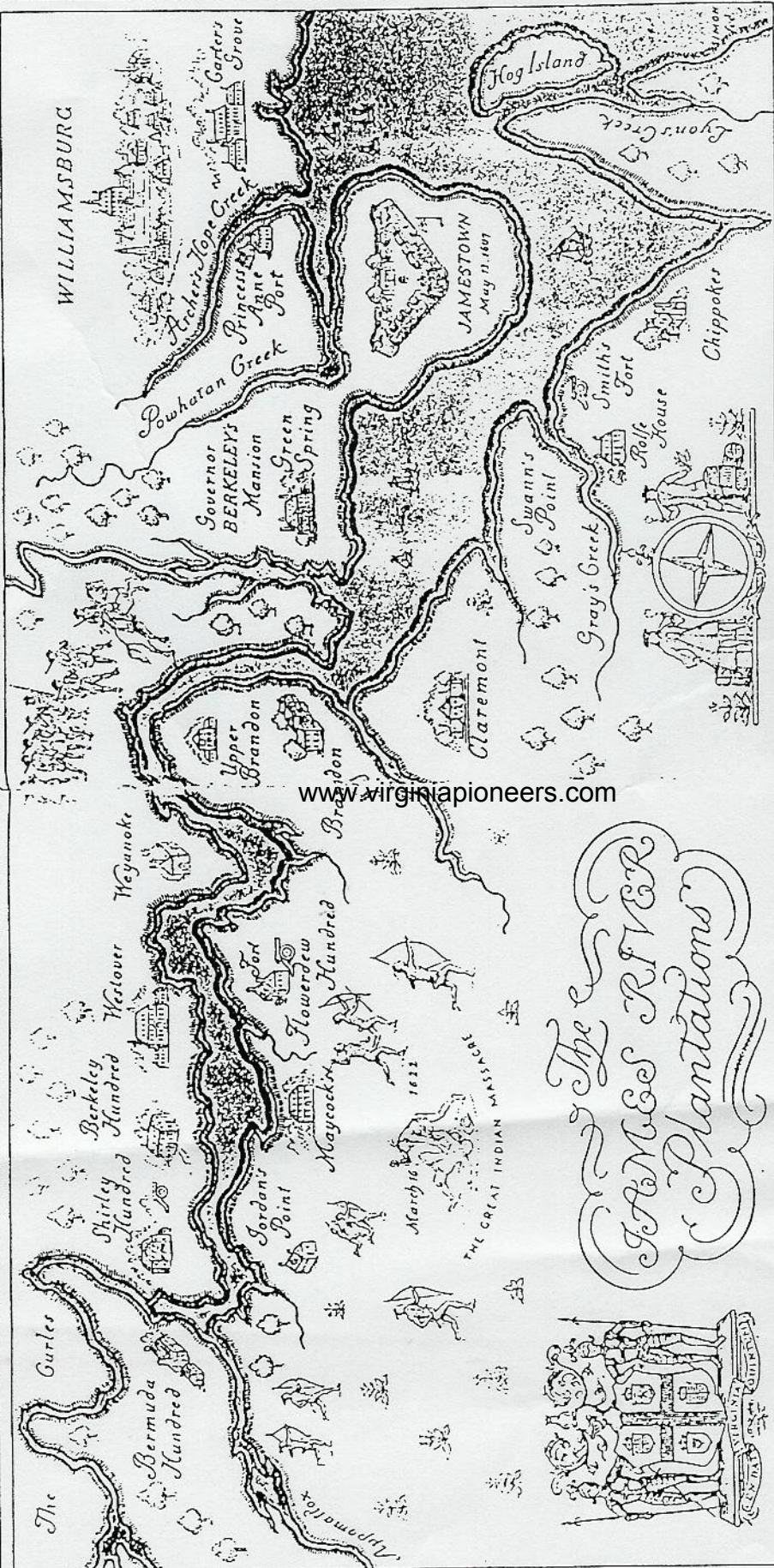

The great plantation of the Virginia colony stretched along the James River, inland from the original fort and settlement at Jamestown. Berkeley Hundred lies on the north bank, between Shirley, the seat of
