At a Court held for James City County and the City of Williamsburg, at the Courthouse thereof, in said City on Monday the 9th day of October 1882.

A Writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Richard Ashlock, deceased, bearing date on the 1st day of September 1882. Was this day presented to Court, and upon the Testimony of Geo E. Gessy one of the subscribing Witnesses thereto, who made oath, That Richard Ashlock acknowledged and subscribed the same in his presence and in the presence of Rebecca Wallace, the other subscribing Witness thereto, ^{and for} as his last will and Testament. they the said Geo E Gessy and Rebecca Wallace, at the request of the testator and in his presence subscribed the same as Witnesses, they all being present at the same time, which said last will and testament being proven to the satisfaction of the Court. It is ordered that said Writing be recorded as and for the true last will of Richard Ashlock deceased.

And upon the motion of Geo E Gedy, he is permitted to qualify as Executor under the will whereupon he appeared in Court. and took the usual Oaths required by law. and Entered into Bond in the penalty of One hundred Dollars (no security being required by the will, It is ordered that letters of administration be made in due form of law for Geo E Gedy as Executor of Richard Ashlock deceased
