14th day of May 1876 signed and sealed this instrument and published
and declared the same as and for his last will and we at his
request. and in his presence and in the presence of each other have
here unto written our names and subscribing witnesses
Richard Wallace
William A Jones

At a Court held for James City County and
the City of Williamsburg. at the Courthouse
thereof in said City on Monday the 12th day of
June 1876.

A writing purporting to be the last will and testament of
Thomas Henley, bearing date on the 14th day of May 1876. was this day
presented to Court, and upon the testimony of Richard Wallace Tom A Jones
and Wm Jones. three subscribing witnesses thereto, who made oath. That
Thomas Henley decd. acknowledged the same as his last will and testament
in their presence, they all being present at the same time, and they the said
Richard Wallace, Tom A Jones and Wm Jones. at the request of the testator and in his
presence, and in the presence of each other subscribed the same as witnesses
which said will and testament being fully proven to the satisfaction of the
Court. It is ordered that the same be recorded as and for the last will and
Testament of Thomas Henley decd.

And upon the motion of Dennis Wright, the Executor therein named
he is permitted to qualify as Executor of Thomas Henley decd. whereupon
he appeared in Court and took the usual oath required by law. and together
with Richard Wallace and John Jones as his securities (who justified as to their
sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of fifty
Dollars. Conditioned as the law directs, It is ordered that letters of administration
be granted to said Dennis Wright as Executor of Thomas Henley decd.
