Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my Sister Ursley Whit one black Cow & Calf and all her increase for live and at her death, the said Cow and all her increase to my Grandson John Thomas Walls.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my Son in law William R. Hazlewood One Dollar. to be his entire interest in my Estate.

Item 4th The remainder to be divided into five equal parts, my Son Elijah Walls. to have two parts. the other three parts. I give and bequeath to the heirs of my daughter Sarah, Wife of William R. Hazlewood.

Item 5th I do appoint my friend Richard T. Tyree. as my executor of this my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby revoke and make Void all former Will or Wills by me at any time or times heretofore made.
