shall be valued at Two Hundred
dollars in said division of my
estate, to him and his heirs forever.

The remaining half of my es-
tate I give to be equally divided
between the children of my friend
R.B. Roy Esqr. of this County, and do
hereby constitute and appoint
Dr. R. H. Cox and R.B. Roy Executors
of this my last will and Testament
with the request that the Court
requiring no security of them and
that they shall be empowered to
divide the property herein bequeathed
to suit their own wishes and mind
in every particular with the ex-
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ations which I have placed upon the farm
on which I now reside which shall be as-
signed to the before mentioned Rich-
ard H. Cox Jr. at the nominal value of
two hundred dollars given under
my hand this second day of May
Eighteen hundred and Seventy one
