

11^o I bequeath to son Alfred Smith of sound mind make this my last will as follows.
 12^o I give to my son Robert Nesser Smith, my gun
 and to my son Alfred Smith Jr. my watch,
 13^o The balance of my estate real and personal
 after the payment of my debts, I leave to my
 widow as long as she remains my widow, if
 she remains or dies, I direct that the bal-
 ance of my estate be equally divided among
 my children Sarah Ann Smith, Robert R.
 Smith, Alfred Smith Jr and Mary L. Smith.
 I have my widow Sarah C. Smith, my wife
 etc. and request the Court to permit
 her to qualify without requiring security
 of her. Witness my hand and seal this
