

11th I helped F. Smith of sound mind make this
my last will as follows,

1st I give to my son Robert Rosser Smith, my gun
and to my son Alfred Smith Jr. my watch,
2nd The balance of my estate real and personal
after the payment of my debts, I leave to my
widow as long as she remains my widow, if
she remains or dies, I direct that the bal-
ance of my estate be equally divided among
my children Sarah Lou Smith, Robert R.
Smith, Alfred Smith Jr. and Mary L. Smith.
3rd I leave my widow Sarah C. Smith, my ex-
ecutor and my next of kin, the Court to per mit
her to qualify without requiring security
of bond. Witness my hand and seal this
29th day of August 1883.
