First I will and That all my just debts shall be
paid. Second. I hereby bequeath and devise all
my estate both real and personal whether in posses-
sion or in The form of Bonds or accounts or other
securities to my beloved wife Anselbia H. Gatuwood
for her sole use and benefit so long as she shall
remain my widow, and at her death to be equ-
ally divided between my two children, Matie
L. Gatuwood and Philip J. Gatuwood. But should
my said wife marry again, Then it is my will
That upon such marriage she shall receive such
dower and other provisions as are provided by The
Law of Virginia for widows, and The balance
of my estate at once divided between my said
children as above directed. Third I hereby
appoint my said wife Anselbia H. Gatuwood
sole Executrix of this my last will and tes-
tament, and request and direct That she shall
not be required to give any security for The
proper execution of The trust hereby reposed
in her by me, wholly written in my own
proper hand writing and signed and
sealed as my last will and testament
