I Charles A. Roane of the County of King
 & Town and State of Virginia, do make this
 be my last Will and Testament

1st

I leave my wife Matilda J. Roane, Luther M.
 Roane and Richard A. Roane my Executors
 and request that the Court will allow them to
 qualify on my estate without giving Security,

2^{ndly}

My will and desire is that they shall act jointly
 together in managing and holding my estate, both real
 and personal together for the benefit of my wife and
 children until the youngest shall marry or arrive
 at the age of twenty one years

3rd

Then I desire that my wife shall take her dower
 right of my estate both real and personal, and the
 remaining two thirds shall be equally divided between
 my children, provided she remains my widow.
 Should she marry again or at her death my
 desire is that all my estate both real and personal
 shall be equally divided among my children.
