And I give all my lands tenements and appurtenances all my furniture and all my stock alive, Cows, hogs &c unto my dear wife Lucy Banks for and during her life, and from and after my decease, I give and devise all the said property lands furniture, stock of all kinds and all other property of which I may die seized and possessed to my children Betty Banks who was born to me by my first wife and Delaware Banks and Emmet Banks children born to me by my second wife and to them heirs forever. Subject however to the deduction of the following legacies - I give and devise to my son Latane Banks Twenty five cents. I give and devise to James Banks Thirty five cents. I give and devise to George Banks Thirty five cents. and I give to Frank Robt Banks Thirty five cents and to them heirs forever. And I lehuncille Banks appoint George H. Lervouch Executor of this my last will and testament. On the qualification of George H. Lervouch as Executor of this my last will and testament. I request and direct that no security be required of him. In witness whereof I the said lehuncille Banks have here set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th day of December 1889.
