I Chumkille Banks of the County of King George State of Virginia do make this my last will and testament, that is to say my wish and desire is to be buried with as little expense as decency will permit and that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as conveniently may be. And I give all my lands tenements and appurtenances all my furniture and all my stock oxen, Cows, Hogs &c unto my dear wife Lucy Banks for and during her life, and from and after her decease, I give and devise all the said property, lands, furniture, stock of all kinds and all other property of which I may die seized and possessed to my children Betty Banks who was born to me by my first wife and Delawan Banks and Emmet Banks children born to me by ^{my} second wife and to their heirs forever. I subject however to the deduction of the following legacies - I give and devise to my son Latane Banks twenty five cents. I give and devise to James Banks twenty five cents. I give and devise to George Banks twenty five cents and I give to Jacobus Banks twenty five cents and to their heirs forever. And I Chumkille Banks appoint George W. Lerouch Executor of this my last will and testament. On the qualification of George W. Lerouch as Executor of this my last will and testament. I request and direct that no security be required of him. In witness whereof I the said Chumkille Banks have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th day of December 1889.

Fannie W. Revere —
