

I, Edwin B. Loven of the County of King & Queen and State of Virginia, do hereby make my my last will and testament as follows; 1st I desire that all of my just debts be paid - 2^d I give to my wife Henrietta Loven all of my estate, both real & personal, to be held by her during her life, or so long as she remains my widow, & 3^d In death, or should she marry again, my will is, that all of my property of every description be then equally divided between my three children Owen B. Loven, James Edgar, & Sallie B. Loven should any of the children die before coming into possession of the property above devised and leaving no lawful heir, I then desire it to be divided equally between the remaining children; My will also is, that my son Owen B. Loven shall have a home at my residence so long as he remains single, or so desires. As witness my hand and seal this 11th day of August 1886 -
