3<sup>rd</sup> I desire that all my just debts be paid out of the  
said estate.

4<sup>th</sup> As my Will and desire that my wife Susan  
shall have one third of my estate of every kind and  
the remaining two thirds to be equally divided bet-  
ween my Son Erast that is Erast Taylor and  
Taylor
