the division of my sister Marthas land
to Grey or Longest.
- 6th I give to Laura Miner six acres of land
at the place where Peter Griggs lived at the
house and garden spot.
- 7th I give to Fannie Banfoot ten acres of land
adjoining Louises
- 8th I give to Isabella Scott ten acres adjoining same
- 9th I give to Martha Wood six acres of land adjoining same
- 10th I give to Maria Wood twenty acres of land during
her life and at her death to her son R.W. Wood
- 11th all the Remains of my land I give to Dr. J. H.
Hutchinson during her life and at her death
to Patti, Bettie, and Ned.

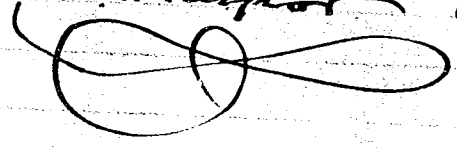
