

In the name of God Amen I George Gilmon of the County of King and parish of St Stephens do hereby declare this to be my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments heretofore made by me by First My Will and desire is, that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate by my Executors herein named. Secondly I lend to Julia Ferguson all of my property both real and personal during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided between her two sons John D Ferguson and James Ferguson (should they survive her) to them and their heirs forever, but should her said sons John D Ferguson and James Ferguson die before the said Julia Ferguson (their mother) or before they should arrive to the age of twenty one years or marriage, then and in that case I give and bequeath the said property thus loaned to the said Julia Ferguson during her natural life to all my brothers and sisters that may be living at the time of the death of the said Julia Ferguson, to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever but my Will and desire is that my Land shall not be sold during the life of the said Julia Ferguson but kept together for the support of her two sons as above mentioned.

Lastly, I appoint my friend A G D Roy my true and lawful executor of this my last Will and Testament.

I Benjamin Fleet of the County of King and Queen in the State of Virginia being in my perfect senses, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following; Revocable, all former Wills by me at any heretofore made. 1st I direct all my just debts to be paid which can be done most certainly by collecting what is due me by bonds and open accounts, and by the sale of my crops on hand at the time of my death; but should these funds prove insufficient, then I direct my executors hereinafter named to sell at public auction on a credit of six months my store house and lot at Walkerton in King and Queen County, and apply the proceeds as far as may be necessary to the payment of my debts. And if there should still be not enough to pay all my debts, I desire my said executors to arrange with my creditors to wait until other crops can be made and sold & the proceeds applied to the discharge of such of my debts as may still remain unpaid.

(2nd) I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Maria Louisa
Fleet in fee simple the sum of two thousand dollars
and also the following slaves to wit Phillis and Mary
and all their present and future increase

3. I desired all the residue of my estate to be kept together and now is except my stone house and lot at
