the money due me by James Le Council after paying my
funeral expenses I direct that the same shall be divided equally
between Mrs. Margaret Dundas My Niece Aunt Bachel

I direct that my Virginia State Bonds shall be equally
divided between my Nephews and Nieces namely the children
of Richard I Bush and John I Bush My Executor is also
requested to pay fifty dollars which I have in my possession
at this time in specie to Doct Henry Skilton. I also give one
Bouquet to Sallee Purdett colored woman.

Lastly I appoint James W Smith Executor of this my
last Will and Testament and desire that the Rev John E
Purpin shall be requested to preach my funeral and my
Executor is directed to pay him five dollars
