

1st I, John Radford do make this my last will and testament, 1st I give all of my property of every description to my wife Saphronia, during her widowhood or life, she to be authorized to sell or dispose of any of the personal estate for the support of herself and minor children, or the payment of my just debts.

2nd Upon the marriage or death I give what remains of my personal estate to my children by her the said Saphronia, and my real estate to all of my children to be equally divided among them.

3rd I do not wish any appointment or sale of my personal estate, except what may be made by my wife as above stated.
