

I Joseph Collin of King and Queen County do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit that is to say first I desire that all the perishable part of my estate be immediately sold after my decease And out of the moneys arising there from all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid. Should my perishable be more than sufficient to pay my just debts and funeral expenses then I desire that my executor hereafter named may lend out at legal interest untill my Grandson Thomas Dudley arrives at the age of twenty one years old or untill his death should he not live untill he arrives at that age but should he live to be the age of twenty one I then lend to my Grandson Thomas Dudley all the money that may remain after paying my debts & funeral expenses including the interest that will have accumulated when he arrives to that age & at the death of my Grandson Thomas Dudley I give the same to the lawfully begotten children of the said Thomas Dudley but should my Grandson die without a lawfully begotten child then I give the money above named to my Nephew John Collin

2^d I lend to my Grandson Thomas Dudley the tract of land on which I live (the same to be from 25 or to 30 acres) During his life and at his death I give the said tract lawfully begotten children of the said Thomas Dudley if any be then living but if my Grandson Thomas Dudley die without leaving a lawfully begotten child I then give the above mentioned tract of land to my Nephew John Collin

3^d Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Frederick Blund executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me made in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 18th day of August One thousand eight hundred and thirty four
