and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall
come to his hands possession or knowledge of him the said Rodrick Blaind or
into the hands or possession of any other person or persons, for him: and the
same, or more, do exhibit to the County Court of King and Queen at such
time as he shall be there to be required by the said Court; and the same goods
chattels and credits, do well and truly administer, according to law; and make
a just and true account of his doings and things therein when thereunto
required by the said Court; and further, do well and truly pay and deliver all
the legacies contained and specified in the said Will as far as the said goods
chattels and credits will extend according to the value thereof; and as the law
shall charge him then this obligation to be void, or else to remain in full
force
