- 1 I desire all of my just debts shall be paid
- 2 I give to my daughter Mariah A. Munday my House, and all the land in the field as it is now laid off next to Tho: M. Garrett, also the land next to Thos. M. Garrett in the field on the road, commencing at a Locust by the fence dividing the two fields below the road, thence to a Holly on the main road; thence down the road to a gate on the left side of said road, thence along the road over used to the land of Alexander Dudley's Est. to a Maple on the side of the road, and in the line of said Dudley's Est. all the land between said road, and adjoining Alexander Dudley's Est. to the land of Jacob M. Turner. Also a roan Colt called Nellie Choice goat of oxen, or cart, choice cow, yearling called Spark, Corn Sheller, Choice bedstead with all necessary bedding for the same
- 3 I give to my son James J. C. Munday, all the balance of my land next to Mrs. B. Bird & Alexander Dudley's Est., And Mariah A. Munday and J. T. C. Munday are to pay fifty dollars each to each one of my three grand children Adeline J. Peace, John L. Peace, and Sydney A. Peace for their interest in my estate. And the land above given to Mariah A. & J. T. C. Munday is to be bound for the payment of the three hundred dollars given to the said grand children mentioned
- 4 I give all the balance of my property to my daughter Mariah A. & son J. T. C. Munday, to be divided between them, or sold as they may think best for a division, by their paying all my

just debts as first mentioned above
 5 I leave my Son Darius J.C. Hundley my Ex-
 utor, and hope the Court will allow him to qual-
 ify without giving security.
