 This writing purporting to be the last will
 testament of Lewis Hart died: was produced
 in Court by Geny I Hart and Richard A
 Davis the Executors therein named, and there
 being no subscribing witnesses thereto, B. F.
 J. Taylor Clerk of the Court and John W.
 Jackson, even sworn and solemnly de-
 posed that they are well acquainted with
 the testator having written and very clearly
 the said writing and the names thereto sub-
 scribed to be truly written by the testator
 own hand. Whereupon the said writing is
 ordered to be received as the last will
 and testament of Lewis Hart died:
 And on the Motion of the said Geny I.
 Hart and Richard A. Davis the Executors
 therein named who made oath that
 entered into and acknowledged before me
 the solemnity of our Hearsaid declaration.

And the said Richard A Davis in the Senate of
the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (1800) Constituted as the
said Davis, without security the testator having
referred in his said will that in security be
refused of his said executor. Subscribed is
granted each of them for obtaining a probate
of said will in due form.
