 form

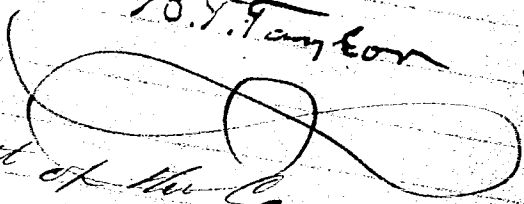
