 ation named shall not let him suffer but afford him
 maintenance

I desire and direct that my executor after
 taking out the Legacies specified above shall divide
 upon such terms as he may think best, all and every
 article of my estate both personal and real and all
 the profits arising from such sale equally among
 my relations, William Wagns, Matilda
 Chapman who was Matilda's Son, William Mun-
 terland, and John Levi Verlander.
