 dollars, and I give the remainder of my property
 to the four minor sons of Edwin & Leah
 Watkins as hereinafter to be named as
 follows, To Benjamin Watkins all my fur-
 niture, beds and bed clothes with the excep-
 tion of one white Corn cupboard, which I desire
 shall be given to Henry Watkins, The remain-
 der of my property I desire to be equally
 divided, Peter Dorsey, Henry and Worthy Wood
 Watkins, all three of whom are infant sons
 of Edwin and Leah Watkins as aforesaid
 I desire my friend Edwin Watkins to act
 as my executor and that no security be
 required of him in his qualifying as such
 In witness whereof, I, the said testator, Mar-
 garet Dunn have hereunto set my hand
 and seal on this 17th day of August 1887.
