

In the name of God Arisen I Mary Ann

being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make
and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following that is to say

Item 1st I wish all my just debts to be paid out of my
estate hereafter named as soon as practicable after my death
Item 2nd I leave to my sister Nancy Watkins for and
during the term of her natural life, all my household and
the like furniture and at her death I give and bequeath the
same to such Child or Children as she may leave living
at the time of her death.

Item 3^d All the balance of my Estate both
real and personal moving bonds &c I wish sold and
executed by my said Executor and divided as follows
Item 4th One third of such balance of my Estate
I give and bequeath to my brother William Fenton of
Kings but should my said brother die before me at this time or at the time
of my death I give and bequeath the said last mentioned
third to such Child or Children as he may leave surviving him
capable & gotten of his body. But should my said brother
die without such Child or Children surviving him I give the
same to the Children of my Sister Nancy Watkins and the Children
of my deceased Sister Joanna Watkins, one half being set
aside to the Children of my said Sister Nancy and the other
half or ninety dollars to the Children of my said Sister Joanna.

Item 5th One fifth part of such balance of my Estate
I give and bequeath to such Child or Children of my deceased
Sister Joanna & at her death as may be living at the time of my
death and if either of my said Sister Joanna's Children should
die before me or should attain the age of twenty one years old
shall go to the survivor or survivors of them with the same
time & right before her death.

Item 6th The remaining third of such balance
of my Estate I will and desire shall be held by my
Executor in Trust for the Children of my Sister Nancy Watkins
one equal share of which I would have said Executor to pay to him
or her as he or she shall respectively attain the age of twenty
one years or marry and should any son or man of my said

Item 2nd I lend to my sister Nancy Watkins for use
during the term of her natural life, all my household and
the return furniture and at her death I give and bequeath the
same to such Child or Children as she may leave living
at the time of her death.

Item 3^d All the balance of my Estate both
real and personal money, bonds, &c. I will sell and
conclude by my said Executor and divide as follows
Item 4th One third of such balance of my Estate
I give and bequeath to my brother William Scovely of
Kingsbury, but should he die at the time or at the death
of my deceased I give and bequeath the said last mentioned
third to such Child or Children who may leave surviving him
lawfully begotten of his body. And should my said brother
so die without such Child or Children surviving him I give the
same to the Children of my Sister Nancy Watkins and the Children
of my deceased Sister Joanna Watkins, one half thereof
to go to the Children of my said Sister Nancy and the other
half or ninety pounds to the Children of my said Sister Joanna.
Item 5th One third part of such balance of my Estate
I give and bequeath to such Child or Children of my deceased
Sister Joanna Et al hirs as may be living at the time of my
death and if either of my said Sister Joanna's Children should
die before me or should attain the age of twenty one years, it
shall go to the survivor or survivors of them with the same
last partition last before exprest.

Item 6th The remaining third of such balance
of my Estate I will and desire shall be held by my
Executor in Trust for the Children of my Sister Nancy Watkins
one equal share of which I will have my said Executor to pay to him
or her to her or him shall respectively attain the age of twenty
one years or marry. And should anyone or more of my said
Sisters Nancy's Children die before he or she receives his or her
portion of my Estate, I wish his her or their portion of my
estate to go to his her or their surviving brothers and sisters
to be paid as aforesaid by my said Executor as such
survivor or survivors respectively attain the age of
twenty one years.

Item 7th Should my before mentioned brother
William die leaving a child or children lawfully begotten

of his body, and should all the children of my said Sister Nancy
die before receiving their portion of my said Estate I desire
and bequeath that portion of my Estate before given my
said executors in trust for them to the Children of my said
brother William and the Children of my said Sister Joanna
one half or moiety thereof to the Children of my said brother
and the other half to the Children of my said Sister Joanna

Lastly I appoint my friend John W. Watkins
executor of this my last will and testament witness
my hand and seal this 11 day of Decr in the year 1857
