 of sound mind make this my last will
 as follows, let 1st I give to my daughter
 Henrietta Gregg my real and Called-
 out 2 I leave to my daughter Emily
 Dunn wife of Lewis Dunn, the land on
 which they live, during her life, at her
 death I give it to her Children.
 let 3 I leave to my widow Peggy Brown
 the land on which we now live, during
 her life, at her death I give to Robert
 J Griffith and Minnie H Griffith
 Children of Henrietta Gregg.
 let 4 I leave to my widow Peggy Brown
 during her life, all money, bonds and
 other personal estate held by me, except
 the Cow given my daughter Henrietta
 Gregg, at her death I give it to
 Thomas Latane Trustee for my daughter
 Emily Dunn & Children and Robert J
 Griffith and Minnie H Griffith Children
 of my daughter Henrietta Gregg.
 let 5 I direct that Thomas Latane shall at
 the death of my widow Peggy Brown
 invest my personal estate in some
 interest bearing fund, one half
 of which shall be for the benefit of
 Emily Dunn and Children and the
 other half for Robert J Griffith and
 Minnie H Griffith Children of Henrietta
 let 6 I direct that Thomas Latane Trustee
 shall pay to Emily Dunn the interest
 on the fund secured to her & her Children
 during her life at her death the
 principal is to be paid to her Children.
 let 7 I direct that Thomas Latane Trustee

shall have the interest on the fund saved to
Robert J Griffith and Minnie H Griffith for
their support during their minority, when
Robert J Griffith attains the age of 21 years
the principal shall be equally divided
between them, Given under my hand this
18th day of March 1881 -
