

This is the Last Will and Testament of me Susan Wright (widow) of Kings and Queens County Virginia, but now sojourning in Port Richmond, Richmond County New York, that is to say:

First

Order and direct my Executors hereafter named to pay off and discharge all my just debts and liabilities, and funeral expenses.

Second

I hereby authorize, empower and direct said Executors to sell and convert into money (at any time after November 1st 1873) all my estate real and personal in the State of Virginia, or elsewhere, and good and sufficient deeds, and bills of Sale of the same execute and deliver: And I hereby direct that of my executors residing in Virginia to turn over such money as fast as realized to the three of my executors in the next clause of this Will particularly named

Third

All of my Estate so converted into money and all other estate which I may die possessed of or entitled to, I give devise and bequeath to the following named of my executors viz: Garrett P. Wright and John Crittenden in trust, and for the following uses, purposes and trusts viz: To invest the same in United States Government Bonds, or in good interest bearing Securities, and to keep the same and the interest which shall thereon accrue, and at interest, until the youngest of my children hereinafter named shall arrive at full age. And upon the arrival of the youngest of my said children at full age, to dispose of the said money as follows: First - To pay to my son

John E. Wright the sum of One Thousand dollars, Second, to pay to my daughter Mary Adelaide the sum of One thousand dollars Third - to divide the residue of said money and the interest thereupon into five equal parts. and to pay the same as follows: To my daughter Florence L. Wright - to my said daughter Mary Adelaide Wright, to my said son John E. Wright, to my son David D. Wright, and to my daughter Irene E. Wright each, one of said shares

In case either, or any of my said children shall die before arriving at the age of twenty one years, then and in that case, I direct that the share of the one so dying shall be paid over to my surviving children, share and share alike

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint as my executors and Trustees Garrett P. Wright and John Crittenden of the County of Richmond New York State, and I also nominate and appoint Garrett P. Post, Capt. St. Johnis and Hansford Anderson of the State of Virginia my executors for the purpose of raising and assisting said three first named executors in settling up my property in Virginia

I hereby revoke all other and former wills by me made. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Port Richmond aforesaid this twenty first day of June A.D. 1873

The foregoing instrument was on the day of its date subscribed by Susan Wright the testatrix therein named in the

presence of each of us, who have subscribed
our names as attesting witnesses thereto, at
the request of said Testatrix and in her pre-
sence and in the presence of each other. At
the said Testatrix, at the time of making
subscription did acknowledge that she had
so subscribed the same, and did declare
instrument so subscribed by her to be her
last Will and Testament.

In King & Queen County Court December 11th 1871
This writing purporting

Will of Susan Wright, late of this County decd: was returned into Court, together with the Commission thereto annexed for taking the attestation of the witnesses thereto, and the certificate under the hand ^{and} seal of George Gallagher a Notary Public of the City of New York of the State of New York of the execution of the said Commission. And thereupon the said certificate, being seen and inspected by the Court, it is ordered that the said writing be recorded, as the true last will and Testament of Susan Wright decd. And on the motion of Hansford Anderson Esq. and Garrett Post, two of the Executors therein named who made oath thereto, and together with A. Freeman Post and William D. Leigh their Sureties, who justified on oath as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars (\$5000) conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form, liberty being reserved to the other Executor named in the said will to join in the probat when he shall think fit.
