sheep & 3 hinds, or their value, being equal
to what I have already given to my daugh-
ter Lizzie C. Didlake. The remainder of
my personal estate, to be equally divided
between my two daughters Mary F. Clegg
& Lizzie C. Didlake. My real estate $\frac{1}{4}$
acre & right of way to same, to be for fam-
ily burying ground, I give and bequeath
to my daughter Lizzie C. Didlake, in fee
simple to her and to her heirs forever.
One hundred acres of land to the west
of my farm, the line to run straight from
the County road, to the North line of the
farm, provided the line does not run
in less than thirty yards of the barn,
The line under no circumstances to be
less than thirty yards of barn. The remainder

of my real estate I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary F. Clegg in fee simple, her & to heirs forever. I direct and request my daughter Mary F. Clegg to give a room in the house and a support to Miss Alice M. Dillard.

the remainder of her life. I do hereby constitute and appoint Miles C. Dillace executor of this my last will and testament, and request that the Court require no security to his bond. Given under my hand this the 12th day of August Eight hundred and eighty seven
