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2. This, N. Jeffries do make this my last will & testament
fully revoking all others;

1st I devise to my son Thos. E. Jeffries in full simple
the tract of land known as "Sunny side," adjoining
the lands of Mrs. Pearce and others, also the
tract of land known as "The Ponds" opposite D;
Garrett's;

2nd I devise to my son George W. Jeffries in
full simple that part of the tract of land on
which I now reside included in following lines
commencing at a white oak on Myrtle Plains
line thence to main road along line of main
road at old gate, thence along road to a spruce
pine, thence across new ground to Mrs. Trus-
tall's line in the swamp, thence along Mrs.
Trustall's line to Joel & Brays line, thence along
his line to Geo. B. Yarnall's line, thence
along his & Myrtle Plains to beginning at
the white oak,

3rd I give to my daughter Lucy B. Spencer my
interest I may have from any source whatever
in the land known as the main line of which
I became possessed by marriage with her mother,
Maria who before her marriage was Maria
Subant, I also give her during her life the
tract of land on which she now resides, and
the balance of the tract of land on which I
live that is not given to my son George W. Jeffries
and at her death both of said tracts of land
are to go in full simple to her children,

4th I give to my grand-daughter Mary B. Jeffries
the sum of Five hundred dollars, which is to
be held by my son George W. Jeffries without
seeing, for her use & benefit until she reaches
or attains the age of twenty one years when
he is to pay it to her without interest, and
in the event of her death before that time
