the 14 day of December 1865

His last Will and Testament of Anne Bland deceased was offered for probate by Benjamin Bland the Executor therein named and was proved by the oaths of James Carr and James H. Gosnell two of the witnesses thereto subscribed and is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Benjamin Bland who made oath thereto and without security (no security be required by the said Will) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penal sum of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

In the name of God Amen I William Bird of the County of King and Queen do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments heretofore made by me viz

First I desire that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate by my Executors hereinafter named

Secondly I desire my Executors will sell on a credit of 14 months my two tracts of Land lying in the County of King and Queen, the one known by the name Quarter and adjoining John H. Thurston, the other my Mansion house tract adjoining Corbin Watkins and take bonds with good security for the purchase money together with the value of my personal Estate together with my bonds and accounts and the money arising from the sale of my lands personal estate bonds and accounts connected I desire shall be laid off in five equal parts First last our fifth part, I give to my daughter Fanny A. Bird to her and her heirs forever - And last our fifth part, I give to my

(A) grand daughter Martha Ann Bird to her and her heirs
forever (3rd) last one fifth part I give to my grand
daughter Hannah H Bird to her and her heirs forever
provided that she the said Hannah H Bird arrives
to the age of twenty one year or marries. But should
my grand daughter die before she arrives to the age
of twenty one year or marries then the property then
devise to her my grand daughter Hannah H Bird
I give to my grand son Musco S Gatewood to him
and his heirs forever 4th last one fifth part I give
to my grand daughter Frances A Bird to her and her
heirs forever. 5th last one fifth part I give to my grand
son Musco S Gatewood to him and his heirs forever.

Now it is my desire that my executors will pay
to my daughter Helen Garritt coles in her marriage with
Adolphus Garritt the sum of five dollar, also to my
son F M Bird the sum of five dollar to them and
their heirs. Now my further Will is, that all of my
wearing apparel, shall be divided between Musco S
Gatewood son of Joseph B Gatewood and S Gatewood
Bird son of William Bird to them and their heirs
forever. Lastly, I appoint my two friends
Joseph B Gatewood and Edward Walden my true
and lawful executors to this my last will and
testament. In witness whereof I do hereunto set my
hand & seal this fourth day of April eight hundred
and fifty five
