Haynes and Theodor Country~~ and ~~heirs and assigns~~ bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of one thousand dollars, to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Commonwealth, we bind ourselves, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, and also thereby confirm the benefit of our Household and children and to their obligation. Dated with our seals and signed this 25th day of February 1879.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above named William T. Haynes had this day been appointed to qualify as administrator of the goods, chattels and credits of William A. Country and

Now, if the above named William T. Haynes shall faithfully discharge the duties of his said office or trust according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. Signed, sealed, acknowledged and delivered in the presence of
