and being particularly desirous of securing the payment of said bond with interest  
from the date of not punctually paid and in consideration thereof and for the  
further sum of one dollar to have the said Dudley in hand paid by the aforesaid  
Bernard Lippincott and Nathaniel Fox at or before the concluding and delivery  
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained  
and sold and by these presents hath granted bargained and sold alien and released
