thousand dollars, to the payment whereof well and truly to be made to us  
and their successors, we bind ourselves our heirs, execs and attorneys firmly by these  
present witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 25<sup>th</sup> day of  
1812. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the  
Andrew C. Browne hath this day been appointed Committee of the estate of  
Browne dec'd during the contest of the will or until the further order of the  
Court if the said Andrew C. Browne shall well and truly procure the sale  
shall come to his hands, and shall moreover deliver up the said estate to  
or persons entitled to the possession when required by the Court, then the  
obligation to be void or else remain in full force and virtue.
