consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars current money to them in hand
paid by the said Nathaniel Fox before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the
receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, and of the same and every part thereof do
quit, release & discharge the said Nathaniel Fox his heirs Executors and Administrators
forever, by these presents have granted bargained sold released and confirmed unto the said Nathaniel
Fox his heirs executors and administrators the further, all that tract of land, with the
and Bailey Fox's now in the County of New Castle Parish of Saint John formerly
the land of Henry Hobbit etc. of said County containing by estimation forty eight acres
more or less to be the same now or before bounded by the line of the said tract
Geo George Longfellow and all the buildings thereon, to be commutable by the
people etc. to the sum and of one hundred and ten dollars upon the payment of the
sum above mentioned unto the said Nathaniel Fox his heirs Executors and Administrators
for the further sum of one dollar and twenty five cents, to be paid at the rate of the
said tract of land, which and bounded as above, of them the said Bailey Fox and
Sarah his wife, of an acre to the same. To have and to hold the aforesaid land
and all and singular the premises with the appurtenances unto the said Nathaniel
Fox to his wife George and Sarah of the said Nathaniel Fox his wife Executors
and the said Bailey Fox for himself his wife George and Sarah of the said Nathaniel Fox
to and with the said Nathaniel Fox his heirs etc. that he the said Nathaniel Fox
his heirs etc. shall and may from time to time hereafter peaceably and quietly
have hold, occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the said premises without
the least hindrance trouble and molestation of them the said Bailey Fox and
Sarah his wife their heirs etc and shall free and discharge of and from all
other Estates and from all judgments Decrees etc, and further that the
said Bailey Fox and Sarah his wife now their heirs etc claiming in the said
land or any part thereof shall and will at all times hereafter at the request of
the said Nathaniel Fox his heirs etc make any quiet grant with the appur-
tenances to the said Nathaniel Fox his heirs etc. In witness whereof the said

This 1st July 1818 made this 1st day of July one thousand eight hundred and seventeen Between Beverly Robinson of the County of King William and State of Virginia of the one part and George Stoughton of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Beverly Robinson for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five dollars and eighty seven cents to him in hand paid by the said Geo. Stoughton at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have, he and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said George Stoughton his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county aforesaid containing Thirty acres being the land that the said Beverly Robinson purchased from the tract of land belonging to James Ellapie and sold at publick auction by John Hill Sheriff of King William County for delinquent taxes agreeable to an act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided with all and singular its tenements hereditaments and appurtenances unto him the said George Stoughton his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof; and the said Beverly Robinson for himself and his heirs the said land with all and singular the premises before mentioned or intended hereby to be conveyed unto the said George Stoughton his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of the said Beverly Robinson his heirs executors and administrators will so warrant and forever defend by these presents.
