 a search a Judgment lawfully made in any Court within this Commonwealth against the said
 of the negroes aforesaid to satisfy the said Samuel Garbock's debts mentioned in the bond of indenture
 above referred to) after advertising the time and place of such sale of the before mentioned negroes
 bargained and sold ten days at the public Court house of this County proceed to sell the same
 the highest bidder for the best price that can be obtained and out of the money then
 sold in the first place to pay and satisfy all reasonable charges attending such sale
 then to pay and satisfy such debt or judgment as may be returned up against said Edward P Chamberlaine
 Sheriff as aforesaid together with all the legal costs and charges attending the same, and the residue
 money arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the said Bernard Moore his heirs

 do by these presents grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Thomas Patterson his heirs
 & assigns a part of the tract piece or parcel of land whereon the said Richard Gwathmey now lies
 containing by survey was acres be the same more or less & bounded as follows to wit beginning at the said
