 by the said Bernard Moore hath granted licensed and sold and by these presents doth grant
 give and sell unto the said Bernard Deparment and Wm Gregory the following property to wit
 slaves that is to say London Gilbert John Neptune, Randall, Tom and Charlotte with the frame
 are of said Charlotte to have and to hold the said negroes London Gilbert John Neptune
 Randall Tom and Charlotte with her future increase hereon before mentioned to be hereby given
 unto the said Bernard Deparment and Wm Gregory their heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever
 after but nevertheless that the said Bernard Deparment and Wm Gregory shall immediately
 a return or Judgment be made at up in any Court within the County of Westmepeth against the said
 P Chamberlaine Sheriff as aforesaid for damages or costs in consequence of his having made
 of the negroes aforesaid to satisfy the said Samuel Garlick's debts mentioned in the bond of indenture
 above referred to after advertising the time and place of the sale of the before mentioned negroes
 bargained and sold ten days at the public Court house of the County proceed to sell the same
 the highest bidder for the best price that can be obtained and out of the money then
 sale in the first place to pay and satisfy the reasonable charges attending such sale
 then to pay and satisfy such debt or judgment as may be entered up against said Edward P Chamberlaine
 Sheriff as aforesaid together with all the legal costs and charges attending the same and the residue
 money arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the said Bernard Moore his heirs
 assigns or to such person or persons as he by writing under his hand shall appoint and in default
 such appointment to such person or persons as would be then entitled by virtue of the

Thomas Blount of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Richard Gwathney for and in consideration
of the Sum of Ten pounds sixteen shillings in hand paid by the said Thomas Blount the receipt
whereof by the said Richard Gwathney doth hereby acknowledge. Have granted bargained and sold
do by these presents grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Thomas Blount his heirs
& assigns a part of the tract piece or parcel of land whereon the said Richard Gwathney now lies
containing by survey was acres to the same more or less bounded as follows to wit beginning at the said
merry and Blounts corner here standing on Tobacco Mill road running with said road as follows
One pole to a red oak stump made corner to the corner of said Gwathneys land thence by a line
thence by a line to a half pole to an elm tree thence South sixty degrees to the East point
pole to an elm Black Gum thence South five degrees East fifteen pole to a gum in a double line
South seventy one degrees & twenty seven pole to a postless corner in Blounts line thence South seventy
degrees West twenty six pole to another corner postless thence North seventy one degrees West forty
pole to the beginning together with all and singular the privileges, easements & appurtenances thereto
belonging to have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of land and premises hereby conveyed unto
said Thomas Blount his heirs and assigns forever in free absolute & unconditional fee simple to
him and his heirs and assigns & behoof and the said Richard Gwathney doth for himself his heirs
and administrators further covenant and agree to forth the said Thomas Blount his heirs
assigns that he the said Richard Gwathney his heirs executors and administrators the said
and premises hereby conveyed and all and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Thomas Blount
his heirs and assigns will by these presents forever warrant and defend against the right title claim
