This Indenture made this 6th day of May one thousand eight hun-
 dred and seventeen Between Beverly Robinson of the County of King William
 and State of Virginia of the one part and George Staughton of the County of
 State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Beverly Robinson for
 in consideration of the sum of Thirty one dollars and eighty seven cents
 him in hand paid by the said Geo. Staughton at and before the ensuing
 delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
 and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Geo.
 Staughton his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 being in the County aforesaid containing Thirty acres being the land that
 said Beverly Robinson purchased from the trust of land belonging to the
 estate and sold at publick auction by John Will Sheriff of King William
 County for delinquent taxes agreeable to an act of the General Assembly
 that case made and provided with all and singular its tenements, im-
 plements and appurtenances unto him the said George Staughton his
 and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof; and the said
 Geo. Robinson for himself and his heirs the said land with all and
 the premises before mentioned or intended hereby to be conveyed unto the
 George Staughton his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of
 the said Beverly Robinson his heirs executors and administrators with
 its warrant and forever defended by these presents. In witness whereof
 the said Beverly Robinson have hereunto set his hand and seal the day
 year above written.
