

This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day
of April 1818 between Carter M. Braxton and Anna S. M. Braxton
his wife, James H. Henry and Elizabeth Henry his wife, Augustine
M. Braxton, Judith S. Braxton and Robert Carter Braxton
the one part and William P. Taylor of King William County
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Carter, Anna,
Elizabeth, Augustine, Judith and Robert for and in considera-
tion of the sum of five hundred dollars paid at an
before the signing and delivery of these presents have sold
bargained for, aliened and released and confirmed and by
these presents do sell bargain for alien release and confirm
unto the said William P. Taylor and to his heirs forever
eight lots of ground lying and being in the ancient town
of Delawore, otherwise called Steel Point in King William
County, which said lots are known in the place of said town
by the name and denomination of Braxton Lots 9 with all
and singular the houses, orchards, gardens &c together with
all their rights priviledges and appurtenances thereto ad-
-ing, and further all lots held by, or belonging to Carter
Braxton etc. in the said town of Steel point: To have
and to hold the said lots, houses &c to him and his heirs
eternally free from all rents issues profits, divers rebus
or remainders now and forever. And the said Carter,
James, Elizabeth, Augustine, Judith and Robert for
and their heirs now and hereafter do covenant to main-
tain and maintain the said William P. Taylor
quiet, peaceable and undisturbed possession and enjoyment
of the premises herein and for ever or a period forever.
In witness whereof the parties have hereunto set their
hands and affixed their seals this day and year of

King and Queen County to witness
Robert Courtney Justice of the Peace in the County of King
in the State of Virginia do hereby certify that John Carter
Braxton the wife of Carter M. Braxton, and Elizabeth
Henry wife of James H. Henry parties to a certain deed for
the conveyance of real estate to William P. Taylor bearing
date on the 1st day of April 1818 and hereto annexed
personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid, and
being examined by us privily and apart from their husband
and having the deed aforesaid fully explained to them,
the said Anna M. M. Braxton and Elizabeth Henry ad-
mitted the same to be their act and deed, and declared
that they had willingly signed sealed and delivered
the same, and that they wished not to retract it. Given
under our hands and seals this first day of April
1818.
