

This Indenture made this the 18th Day of February in the year
1819, Between Carter M'Drayton of the one part and Robert Pollard
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Carter M'Drayton for & in
consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by the s^d Rob. P.
and the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained
sold, aliened and conveyed, and by these presents hath granted, bargained
sold, aliened and convey unto the said Robert Pollard his heirs, execs &
admins, all of his right, title and interest of, in and to the following
Slaves or negroes, viz. Charles, Kate, Tom, Ben, Zachariah, Carpenter
James, Judy and together with the entire increase of the females.
To have and to hold the aforesaid negroes or Slaves, viz. Charles,
Tom, Ben, Zachariah, Carpenter James, Judy and, with the full
increase of the females to him the said R. Pollard this heirs execs.
In trust nevertheless, and the true intent and meaning hereof is,
that hereinafter contained to the contrary notwithstanding, that should
the said Carter M'Drayton his heirs, execs or admins pay or cause to be paid
unto one James Webb of King and Queen County, the just and full
of One thousand pounds Virginia currency, or about that sum, the
sum of money due from the s^d C. M'Drayton to the s^d Jas. Webb
which s^d sum of money the said C. M'Drayton hath accounted for
with Carter M'Drayton Horbin M'Drayton of King William County
seemingly, then this deed to be void, null & of no effect - Should
the said C. M'Drayton fail to pay off or discharge the s^d debt
the said Webb by him with the said Carter Horbin M'Drayton
when the said debt becomes due, or at any time thereafter
that case the said R. Pollard, should and may proceed after
notification of the same to sell publicly at any place the
negroes or slaves for the purpose of discharging and paying
afore said debt to the said Jas. Webb due as aforesaid.
