This Indenture made this 25th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, between Christopher Tompkins Senior and Anna his wife of the one part and George Turner of the other part. Now this Indenture witnesseth the said Christopher Tompkins sen^r and Anna his wife for and in consideration sum of One hundred and forty dollars and fifty cents to them in hand paid by George Turner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, release and confirm to said George Turner, a tract or parcel of Land containing by a late Survey by John Lumpkin on the 18th day of the present month thirty seven acres, or as follows, Beginning in the Publick road nearly opposite the said Turners in the line between the said parties, and running from thence North 25° E. 100 feet to the Mountain Creek, thence up the said Creek as it may run, thence South 44° W. 25 feet to a small gum corner and

thence up the branch Soppe to a fence at the head of a large quarry running
South 52° W. 100 pds to two cedar posts (one of them dead) on the side
on the Road leading from Hildene to Dabney's Store, thence along the road
to the beginning 42' 4 pds; together with all and singular the premises, enclo-
ments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining,
to the said piece or parcel of Land herein conveyed, in fee simple and unen-
ditable for Tompkins to him the said George Turner, his heirs Executors Administrators
or assigns forever. and the said Christopher Tompkins and Ann his wife for them-
selves, their heirs Execs and Assigns do further covenant and agree to and
with the said George Turner his heirs and assigns, that they the said Christopher
Tompkins and Ann his wife their heirs Execs and assigns, the said Land
and premises herein by them conveyed, and all and every part and parcel
thereof unto the said George Turner his heirs and assigns, will by these presents
covenant and forever defend against the right, title, claim and demands of all
and every person and persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof the said Christopher
Tompkins and Ann his wife do hereunto set their hands, and
affix their seals, the day and date of this indenture.

these presents do make, ordain, authorize and appoint William H. Roane of the
County of King and Queen and State, my true and lawful attorney for me & in
my name and to my use, to ask, and demand, sue for, recover and receive, all
such Lands whatsoever, which are now due and owing unto me the said
John M. Nat (a sergeant of Captain Blyle Martain's Company, Third Regiment
of Rifles who was enlisted the twentieth day of April eighteen hundred and
fourteen to serve during the war that then existed between this Country and
Great Britain and who was honorably discharged at Washington on the Sixth
of April eighteen hundred and fifteen by D. Parker Adj't & Genl Rec'd) from the
United States of America. And to have and to use all lawful ways and
means in my name, or otherwise for the recovery thereof, and to agree and
compromise for the same and acquittances and other discharges for the same, for
me and in my name to make, seal and deliver and to do all other lawful
acts and things whatever concerning the premises, as fully in every respect as
I might or could do, if I were personally present. In witness whereof I have
set my hand and affixed my seal, this twenty third day of Nov: eighteen
hundred & Sixteen -
