At a Court of monthly session held for King William County at the courthouse in New Kent October 1812. The agreement from Warner S. Wormley admitted to the depositions before the Oaths of Ritchieitham, Cannoy Leach and Donald McNeil Murphy thence and to be recorded

This Indenture, Tripartite, made the thirteenth day of January in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and twelve, Between James Littlepage of Manskin Lodge of the one part, Eleanor Wormley, Carter Beverly and John Chew of the second part and Edm^t Littlepage of King William, of the third part witnesseth, that the said James Fox for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand and one hundred and ninety dollars which he stands justly indebted to the said Eleanor Wormley as Administratrix & Carter Beverly and John Chew Administrators under the will of Ralph Wormley esq^r of Lee of Rosegill, and due by two negotiable notes with Capt John Fox as indorser, payable at the Bank of Virginia in the City of Richmond as follows. One for the sum of One thousand and thirty dollars at twelve months after date, and the other for two thousand and sixty dollars at twenty four months after date, both of which notes bear date the 19th day of February 1812 and carry interest from their date, which several sums and interest the said James Fox is desirous to save and wishes honestly to pay to said Eleanor Wormley, Carter Beverly and John Chew or their assigns. And also for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him the said James Fox in hand paid by the said Edm^t Littlepage at and before the concluding and delivery hereof, the receipt of which sum the said James Fox doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof, acquit, release, rate and discharge said Edm^t Littlepage his heirs and executors forever. So the said James Fox hath given, granted, bargained and sold, all released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give grant, bargain sell, let, lease and confirm unto him the said Edm^t Littlepage his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever all that tract piece or parcel of land, situate lying and being on Community river in the County of King William, containing by a survey and plan made by Mr John Fox the 2^d of March 1808 four hundred acres, to the same more or less, being part of Manskin Lodge estate called queen field farm, and purchased by said James Fox of the Administratrix and trustees of Ralph Wormley esq^r and which land is more particularly described in a deed of conveyance from the said Eleanor Wormley, Carter Beverly and John Chew to said James Fox bearing date the 19th day of February 1812, together with all and singular the appurtenances to the before mentioned piece or parcel of land belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all buildings, ways, waters, watercourses, meadows, woods, plantings and emoluments, and the reversion and reversions, remainder remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, with all the estates, rights, title interest, claim property to him whatsoever of him the said James Fox and his heirs, of or and to the before mentioned lands, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging and sold unto him the said Edm^t Littlepage

for his last remanent, joint and several right to all the property
that he the said Edm^d Littlepage his heir, executors, administrators or
confidants may from henceforth hold, use, occupy and enjoy the said land
clear from all other grants, bargains, leases, or incumbrances whatever
nevertheless for the following uses intent & purposed, that is to say, to have
Littlepage his executors, administrators or assigns, soon as he or they shall receive
when ever required by said Eleanor Wormeley, Carter Bevry, John Chew or
either of them, their or either of their executors administrators or assigns, when
both of the negotiable notes become due, shall proceed to advertise the same
in some one news paper published in the City of Richmond, the time and place
of sale, and shall at public auction sell for cash to the highest bidder, the
 premises hereby conveyed and intended to be bargained and sold, with all and
their appurtenances, or so much thereof as shall be by said Edm^d Littlepage his
executors or assigns deemed necessary, and out of the money arising from such
sales, pay the costs of recording this indenture and all contingent and other expences
attending the execution of the trust hereby created, then pay and satisfy the said
Eleanor Wormeley, Carter Bevry and John Chew, or their assigns, the two summe due
notes as aforesaid with the interest and any costs that may have accrued
or otherwise, according to the true intent & meaning of these presents, and the
money, arising by the sales, if any after discharging both the notes, interest
and charges in full, pay or cause to be paid to the said James Fox his heirs
further that the said Edm^d Littlepage his heirs, executors or assigns
ing sale of the property before mentioned, or of any part, he or they shall
execute any lawful deeds or writing for conveying a fee simple estate, of
as shall be sold, to the purchaser or purchasers. It is also agreed between
between the parties, that in the event of either of the aforesaid notes
them being protested for non payment, the holders may sue for the same
under this deed, as he or they may choose or direct, or he or they may
remedies at the same time until the full amount of the claims be received
lastly that whenever the amount of the debts aforesaid shall have been
discharged, this indenture shall become void, and the said Edmund Littlepage
his executors, administrators or assigns shall execute to said James Fox
a proper & lawful release to the premises. In witness whereof the
