

This Indenture made this 29th day of March in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty Between Edward Burke of the one
part and William Burke of the other part both of the County of King William
Maryland that the said Edward Burke for and in consideration of the sum of
Eight hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Burke, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold,
and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said William
Burke his heirs and assigns, all his interest in and to the tract of land
whereon the said William Burke now resides & which said Land was willed by
the parties equally by William Burke their father, and which said tract of land
contains Two hundred acres more or less. To have and to hold the said
land and premises hereby conveyed, and the said Edward Burke doth for himself
this his further covenant and agree to and with the said William Burke that
he the said William shall have, hold occupy and enjoy the said land and
premises hereby conveyed and every part and parcel thereof.

In testimony whereof the said Edward Burke hath hereunto set his hand
and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
