paid or secured to be paid by the said Isaac Bunker at or before the executing and
these presents, the receipt whereof she doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, conveyed
enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents, doth grant, bargain sell, convey
and the said Isaac Bunker, one certain tract piece or parcel of land, situate
being in the parish & County aforesaid, containing by a late Survey
between Johnson Sixty four acres to the acre more or less, and is the tract piece
of land conveyed by Ambrose Bunker the elder, late of the said County of King
to the said Elizabeth Bunker his daughter, by deed bearing date the 25th day of
thousand eight hundred and eight, and recorded in the County Court of King
together with all and singular the hereditaments, emoluments and appurtenances
and belonging in any wise appertaining: to have and to hold the said piece
piece or parcel of land, with all and singular the hereditaments, emoluments and
thereunto belonging, unto him & his heirs & assigns forever, in full and sole
possession, to him and their heirs proper use, benefit and behoof: the
Elizabeth Bunker for herself and heirs executors & administrators doth hereby
will defend the right and title to the aforesaid tract piece or parcel of land
and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging
said Isaac Bunker his heirs and assigns forever, against the claim and demand
