sell, aforesaid transfer and confirm unto the said John Fox all and singular the goods and chattels in

to his executors and administrators when he shall need to and for the safety and convenience
herein after expressed and declared that is to say to prevent and suffer the said Francis West Quarter
his executors or administrators to have profit and use all and singular the said goods and chattels for
and after the date of these presents until the first day of January in the year Eighteen hundred
fifty and from and after the said day last mentioned until the said George William Smith do
require the said John Fox to sell the said goods and chattels or so much thereof as may be suffi-
cient to pay satisfy the said George William Smith the aforesaid One hundred dollars in
case the said George William Smith shall present to the said John Fox the said

receipt of the said Anderson Scott and Edward Carrington or either of them for a sum
several sum of money or any part thereof to them respectively now due or may by
from the said Francis West Quarter that then also and upon receipt of the said
George William Smith as aforesaid he the said John Fox shall with his having
authority to sell by public auction for ready money upon demand

George Miller Esq with the aforesaid herein before first mentioned,
due to him as aforesaid and inasmuch as he gave himself a refund to him the aforesaid
last sum of money or as much thereof as he then then paid to me in consideration
of the value of the same and any balance remaining from said rate I remitted by
paying a satisfying the aforesaid sum of money & charges of running the
said Bills to be restored by said John Fox to said Francis West Quarters his
