 City of Richmond of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Francis West Quarter
 was at the time of the selling and delivery of these presents is justly and truly indebted unto the said
 George William Smith in the sum of One hundred dollars of lawful money; and whereas the
 said George William Smith is and now stands bound upon his affidavit and undertaking to
 pay by the said Francis West Quarter to Anderson Scott of King and Queen County the further
 sum of Forty Dollars of like lawful money and to Edward Harrington of the City of Richmond
 the further sum of One hundred and sixteen dollars and sixty six Cents and two thirds of a cent
 with interest thereon from the twelfth day of February next last past and the said Francis
 West Quarter being desirous as well to secure to the said George William Smith the payment
 of the said first house before mentioned sum as to indemnify and save the said George William
 Smith of from and against the payment of the two last house before mentioned sums to the said Scott and
 Harrington now therefore the said Francis West Quarter in consideration of the premises and for and
 in the further consideration of the sum of One dollar of like lawful money by the said John Fox
 to him the said Francis West Quarter in hand well & lawfully paid at and before the selling and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and he the said John Fox himself forever
 acquitted and discharged by the said Francis West Quarter by these presents hath given granted
 conveyed sold assigned transferred and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain
 sell assign transfer and confirm unto the said John Fox all and singular the Goods and Chattels
 in and amongst the schedule mentioned and contained To have and to hold all and singular the said Goods and
 Chattels in the said annexed schedule mentioned and contained to him the said John Fox and
 to his executors and administrators when trust never thereof and to and for the use and profit
 herein after expressed and declared that is to say to permit and suffer the said Francis West Quarter
 his executors or administrators to have possess and use all and singular the said Goods and Chattels for
 and after the date of these presents until the first day of January in the year Eighteen hundred
 Two and from and after the said day last mentioned until the said George William Smith shall
 request the said John Fox to sell the said Goods and Chattels or so much thereof as may be suffi-
 cient to pay satisfy the said George William Smith the aforesaid One hundred Dollars or
 case the said George William Smith shall produce to the said John Fox the receipt
 receipts of the said Anderson Scott and Edward Harrington or either of them for the
 several sums of money or any part thereof to them respectively now due or owing by
 from the said Francis West Quarter that then also and upon request of the said
 George William Smith as aforesaid he the said John Fox shall and he is hereby
 authorized to sell by public auction for ready money after having

 due to him as aforesaid and undeniably own handship a refund to him the
 last sum of money or so much thereof as he shall have paid to said John Fox
 or to either of them and any balance proceeding from said sale & remaining after

 and. Walter is to be restored by said John Fox to said Francis West Quarter his
