

Christopher Tompkins being
Justice of the County of King William Hunting. Whereas
Separat and Elizabeth his wife have by their Indenture of bargain and sale
bearing date the 15 day of April 1807 sold and conveyed unto Simon Dagg
one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation nearly four acres in
the same more or less lying and being in the County of King William and
whereas the said Elizabeth cannot conveniently travel to our County Court of
King William to make acknowledgment of the said conveyance therefore we do you
and you or any two or more of you power to examine her privately and take the
acknowledgment concerning the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture
which is hereto annexed and we command you that you personally go to the
said Elizabeth and examine her privately and a part from the said James Separat
her husband concerning her executing the said Indenture and take her acknow-
ledgment thereupon and when you have examined her as aforesaid and received
her acknowledgment that you distinctly and plainly testify to us thereof in our
said Court annexed to the writ Writings Robert Pollard clerk of our said Court
the 27th day of April 1807 in the 31st Year of our said foundation Robert Pollard
King William County to wit We do hereby testify that pursuant to the above coming
to us directed we did this day go to the said Elizabeth Separat wife of the above
named James Separat and examine her privately and a part from her
husband and she declared that she willingly signed and sealed the said
Indenture in the said Court as before mentioned which was then shown & read
to her by us and consented that the same may be recorded. Given under

wife of the one part and William Elliott of the County of King
William of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the
sum of five shilling current money by the said William Elliott in
paid to the said George Telle and Maria his wife before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknow-
ledge given granted bargained and sold and do by these presents give
bargain and sell unto the said William Elliott his heirs and assigns
one certain tract or parcel of land being in the County of King William
