This Indenture made the 11th day of January in the year One thousand eight hundred and eleven, Between Gracy Mitchell of the County of King William of the one part and Robert C. Wesley of the same County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Gracy Mitchell for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to her on hand paid, the receipt whereof she doth hereby acknowledge, hath given, granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents give, grant, bargain, sell, release and confirm unto the said Robert C. Wesley, a certain part of the Land purchased of Henry Mitchell which his deceased father gave him by his last Will now in my possession containing according to a survey made by John Fox One hundred & thirteen Acres and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a maple corner standing with John Ellis Land from thence along the said line to a red Oak sapling a new line was

...thence along the said line to a large dynamite at same
line between the two tracts from thence along the said line to the beginning
with all and singular the privileges emoluments and appurtenances thereto belonging
have and to hold the said Land and premises hereby conveyed and all and every part
and parcel thereof unto him the said Robt C Masley his heirs and assigns forever
absolute and unconditional free complete to him and their proper use and behoof and the
said Gracey Mitchell doth for herself her heirs &c and assigns further covenant
agree to and with the said Robt C Masley his heirs and assigns that she the said Gracey
Mitchell her heirs &c shall and lawfully the said Land and premises hereby conveyed and
all and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Robt C Masley his heirs and
assigns well by these presents Warrant and former defend against the right title
and demand of all and every person and persons whatsoever In Witness whereof
said Gracey Mitchell hath hereunto set her hand and seal the day and year
within written.
