

Indent to Bailey

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This Indenture made this ninth day of December One thousand eight hundred and sixteen Between Henry Cobbitt of New Kent County of the one part and Bailey Tor of King William County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Henry Cobbitt for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Bailey Tor before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and of the same and every part thereof do acquit release and discharge the said Bailey Tor his heirs ^{from} by these presents have granted bargained and sold 1st all the land that was given to me by Henry Cobbitt King William County which was allotted off or divided at the New June Court last, containing forty eight and two thirds acres more or less, and bounded by the Land of Mr George Slaughter and Nathan Tor, and all the buildings trees &c to the said tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the woods and meadows, dows, rents issues and profits thereof and every part thereof, all the right title claim interest and demand whatsoever of him the said Tor of in and to him to have and to hold the aforesaid Land, all and singular the premises with the appurtenances unto the said Bailey Tor to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Tor his heirs &c forever. And the said Henry Cobbitt for himself his heirs &c to and with the said Bailey Tor his heirs &c that he the said Henry Cobbitt his heirs &c shall and may from time to time or times lawfully quietly have hold, occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises with the appurtenances of him the said Henry Cobbitt his heirs &c and that he and his heirs &c shall and may from all other Estates

and other circumstances whatever shall and will warrant and prove

This Indenture made this 20th day of April in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven Between Joseph B. Patterson
of Jefferson County and State of Virginia Kentucky of the one part and
Lucy Leitch of the County of King William and State of Virginia of the
other part. Whereas John Patterson late of the State of Kentucky died by
his last will and testament devised a certain tract of Land lying in the
aforesaid County of King William and State of Virginia along with other
real and personal estate to be divided among twelve of his children, a
reference to said will had will more fully appear Where as the said Jo-
seph B. Patterson is entitled to one twelfth part of the said undivided
tract or parcel of land lying as aforesaid. Now this Indenture

hand paid by the said Lucy Leitch unto the said Joseph B. Patterson the
